### **CITATION**

*Born in Poolangudi, in Ramnad District in Tamil Nadu in 1956, Father Felix Raj joined the Society of Jesus in 1973. He graduated with Economics from Loyola College, Chennai in 1980. During his studies at Chennai, he involved himself in the activities of All India Catholic University Federation, a University Student Movement. He represented the AICUF in the Conference of Asian Catholic Students Federation held in Penang in 1979. He has been in this University Student Movement for more than 35 years. In 1989 he took over as the West Bengal State Adviser to the AICUF.*
