Admission Notice

Introduction

Founded by the Society of Jesus, a Christian Religious Order, St. Xavier's College is administered by a Governing Body. Admission is open to all irrespective of caste and creed. However, as a Christian minority institution, Christian candidates will be given certain preference.

Subjects Offered

A. In the application form, candidates are required to mention ONE SUBJECT studied at the Graduation level or at the Post Graduation level (whichever is the highest) from amongst the subjects listed below.

The Subjects offered:

Economics Political Science
English Physical Science
Bengali Mathematics
Hindi Life Science
History Geography

Eligibility

- 50% marks in Bachelors or Masters Degree for General Category and 45% for Reserved Categories.
- Maximum age limit is 40 years as on 1st July 2019 for freshers.
- Besides a good academic record, candidates must have:
 - a. Studied at least one subject offered in the B.Ed. course at St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Kolkata either at Graduation (with at least 300 marks) or at Post Graduate level.
 - b. A good command and fluency in English, both spoken and written.

Procedure for Application

- 1. Application forms are to be filled in & submitted online through the college website www.sxccal.edu from 21.02.2019 (11 am) to 12.03.2019 (1pm).
- 2. Ensure to take a print out of the filled in application form along with the payment receipt and acknowledgement sheet after successful online submission.
- 3. The application will be registered for further processing only after the payment of the Application Fee. The **Application Fee of Rs. 500/-** may be paid by **any one** of the following methods:
 - a. Online, by using Debit Card, Credit Card or Net Banking through the College Website following the successful submission of the online application.
 - b. In cash, only to the Syndicate Bank, Park Street branch located inside the St. Xavier's College Campus through the Bank Challan generated following the successful submission of the online application. Applications for which the payment is made to any other bank/branch will not be registered by the College even if the bank/branch accepts the application fee.
- 4. There is no need to submit the application form or the payment receipt to the College office prior to the interview.
- 5. All relevant documents along with the form and payment receipt need to be submitted at the time of interview.
- 6. The list of candidates selected for interview will be published through the College website.
- 7. The selected candidates need to follow the instructions published with the selection list for appearing in the interview.
- 8. Further information related to interview and selection will be available on the College Website on 26th March after 4pm.

Selection

Level-1: For interview: on the basis of merit considering the academic performance.

Level-2: For enrolment: on the basis of merit considering the academic performance, performance in the interview and co-curricular excellence.

Interview

Based on Subject Knowledge, Communication, General Knowledge, Overall Impression.

- 8. Baptism certificate for Christian candidates and a letter from the Parish Priest.
- 9. For deputed candidates
 - a. Approval of DI of schools.
 - b. Xerox copy of M.C. Resolution countersigned by DI/ADI.
