Professor Bertram da Silva is Associate Professor and Vice-Principal (Arts and Science), St. Xavier's College. After graduating from St. Xavier's College he went on to complete his M.A. in English from Calcutta University. Immediately on completion of his M.A. he joined St. Xavier's College. Having specialized in American Literature, he was invited to teach as a Guest Lecturer at Calcutta University where he took courses in American Fiction for a number of years. Prof. da Silva has chaired and moderated seminars on English and American Literature. Presently he offers courses in Poetry Appreciation and analysis, Shakespearean drama, and Romantic and Modern Poetry.
