DEPARTMENT OF SPORTS ADMISSION POLICY OUTSTANDING SPORTSPERSONS 2019-20

Following is the criteria to be followed for candidates who wish to apply through Category III -Outstanding Sportsperson:

- 1. Candidates need to apply, pay application fees and meet the necessary admission criteria. If an admission test is prescribed for the course applied for, the candidate needs to appear for the same.
- 2. Candidates who meet the following requirement and have sporting achievements IN THE LAST TWO YEARS in the listed sports/games, are eligible to report for Document Verification on dates specified below:
 - Played at the State / National/ International level for tournaments conducted by the State/National/ World Associations of that particular sport
 - Played Hockey, Cricket, Basketball at the 1st/2nd Division level in tournaments conducted by Bengal Hockey Association/Cricket Association of Bengal/West Bengal Basketball Association.
 - Outstanding achievement or a recognised ranking in any sport listed below
- 3. Following documents are required, of which, originals will be verified and photocopies retained by the College:
 - Photocopy of College application form with photograph and Application Fee Bank Receipt.
 - 2 Passport size photographs.
 - Class XII Mark Sheet.
 - Certificates of sporting achievements of last two years meeting above given criteria.
 - Ranking proof where applicable to your Game. (E.g. for Chess, Tennis etc)
 - Identification Card of your Association. (E.g. Bengal Hockey Association, Cricket Association of Bengal, West Bengal Basketball Association etc)
 - Letter of proof from the 1st/ 2nd Division Club a candidate has played for in the last two years with a list of performances.
- 4. Candidates found eligible will be issued a Trial Slip and will report for trials/ interviews. The trial also includes a physical fitness test.
- 5. A candidate placing first or second in any trial may not be shortlisted for admission. Performance at par with the current University / State level or if deemed necessary, College standard is an important criterion. There can be a second or third trial if required.
- 6. If competition and a high standard of performance among candidates is lacking, a candidate can be asked to play along with/ against a current University / College level student to gauge sporting abilities. This can be done so on the trial date or at a later rescheduled date. This is also applicable for team games where candidates are to be prepared to play against the College teams.

- 7. List of shortlisted candidates who are to appear for an interview with the Principal, will be put up on the College web site. Date of declaration of shortlist will be on the trial slip of the candidate or on College Website.
- 8. Final Selection of a candidate depends solely on the discretion of the College Principal.
- 9. A student selected on the Sports Category would need to sign a contract with the College which would bind the student to a set of rules and regulations failing which the student may be removed from the Rolls of the College.
- 10. Candidates falling short of the cut off marks required to apply to the College will be allowed to meet the Principal, with all the above sporting documentation on dates mentioned elsewhere in web site. Candidates found eligible may be allowed to apply. All other Admission rules remain the same for students applying through the Sports category.
- 11. A candidate reporting late will not be allowed to appear for the trials.
- 12. The College reserves the right to cancel an application of a candidate on grounds of misconduct of the applicant or guardian.
- 13. Trials are conducted on and off the Campus, dates and venues of which can be rescheduled due to any unforeseen circumstances.
- 14. It is the sole discretion of the Principal to offer the particular course which a shortlisted candidate has opted for and as such candidates are advised to apply for more than one course as per your qualification and choice.
