Animation of KSOU and the MoU with IBM to train their recruits to appear for MS of Mysore University, the offering of certificate courses in Retail Management and in Real Estate Management in collaboration with CREDAI, Bengal are efforts in line with industry –academia interfacing. The renovated Chemistry and Physics laboratories, and the three computer labs with more than 100 computers, while offering state-of-the-art facilities, challenge staff and students to make technology a handmaid of effective teaching! There are many more achievements I could record and perhaps many failures too-opportunities misses due to our human limitations.. But I wish to take this opportunity to remind all that we have to stand together with trust in God. The next two years should see the institution climbing greater heights even as it enters the 150<sup>th</sup> year of its existence in 2010.


