Online activities for all semester students

In the month of November, the department organised some online quizzes and opinion polls for first and second year students. For third year students and 2020 outgoing students, research assignments were posted on the website with deadlines of 28th December and 30th November 2020 respectively. The objective of conducting these online activities was to create some awareness on various contemporary issues among the students.

2702 students of semester I and III (of main campus) and 135 students of semester I and III (of Raghampur campus) participated in online activities organised by the department. Moreover 77 outgoing students (batch of 2020) from main campus and 4 outgoing students from Raghampur campus completed their social credit through research assignments, provided by the department online.

Beside the above, the department also verified 61 credit sheets (22 of commerce morning students, 2 of business administration students and 37 of arts and science students) and submitted to respective departments.
