Title of the Activity 1: DOCUMENTATION OF UBA ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN BY THE COLLEGE

Need of the Activity: To keep all documentation up-to-date

Brief Description:

In the exiting pandemic situation, field work activities under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan came to a sudden halt. Therefore, the department utilized the time for planning and documentation work.

During this time the annual reports from December 2018 up to April 2020 was finalized and uploaded on the UBA portal.

Title of the Activity 2: VIRTUAL CONFERENCE MEETING WITH RCI-IIT KGP

<u>Need of the Activity</u>: Response to invitation from RCI. To learn from other PI's how they were supporting their adopted villages to prevent and combat COVID-19

Brief Description:

On 4th May 2020 Prof. Cheryl Francis, Ms. Sucheta Mukherjee & Ms. Shrawani Jha participated in a virtual meeting conducted by the UBA for the Participating Institutions under the Regional Coordinating Institute, IIT Kharagpur. In the said meeting representatives from NCI, RCI, and PIs came together to share and discuss about the initiatives undertaken by them for prevention and mitigation of the COVID-19 pandemic in the adopted villages. As a takeaway from the meeting, PIs were encouraged to continue relief operations as well as to plan and prepare Village Development Plan and Project Proposal on the same.

On 13th July 2020, a teleconference was facilitated by IIT Kharagpur (UBA Regional Coordinating Agency) between IIT Delhi (UBA National Coordinating Agency), IIT Kharagpur and St. Xavierøs College. During the hour long conference call, the staff were able to discuss about the following issues faced by St. Xavierøs College as a Participating Institution (PI):

- 1. The auto generated report of Debipur and Shalpukur missing from the PI Dashboard.
- 2. UBA website, the report of Shalpukur is incomplete and the graphs were missing.
- 3. When we tried to print the report of Debipur, due to html format, half of the graphs/tables and the analysis portion was missing.
- 4. When we were trying to upload the survey data, the submit button was missing.
- 5. After uploading the survey data successfully, on a later date it showed that the data was not completed.
- 6. Proposal submitted to produce hand sanitisers.

IIT Delhi staff assured that the technical issues of the reporting portal would be resolved at the earliest. Regarding the proposal, the College was encouraged to submit a revised proposal where the capacity of the villagers would be built to produce hand sanitisers in the village itself. The College is exploring partnership with like-minded organisations to take this initiative forward.

Title of the Activity 3: PROJECT PROPOSAL ON HAND SANITIZER WAS PREPARED

<u>Need of the Activity</u>: To help adopted villages prevent and combat COVID 19 with the use of hand sanitizers.

Brief Description:

A project Proposal on making hand sanitizer was prepared in collaboration with the Dept. of Microbiology. The project was aimed at producing hand sanitizers and distributing the same to the adopted village community members.

However, we did not receive any response from UBA but it was communicated over telephone that such proposal would not be accepted. The training of women in producing the hand sanitizers and making them self reliant would have been appreciated. But due to this pandemic situation this project could not be implemented.

Title of the Activity 4: WEBINARS: SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING FOR NATURE CONSERVATION AND ROLE OF TECHNOLOGIES IN RURAL AREAS FOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT, LIVELIHOOD FOR ATMANIRBHAR BHARAT

Need of the Activity: To learn to use technology for sustainable development in the adopted villages

Brief Description:

The staff attended two webinars which was collaborated by National Coordinating Institute (NCI) ó IIT Delhi. Below is a synopsis of the webinars:

a) International Webinar on Science and Engineering for Nature Conservation scheduled on 5th June 2020: The Webinar was divided into two sections ó (i) Industry

and Environment and (ii) Sustainable Development Vs Developmental Engineering. The sessions focused on advocating for incorporating the environment sensitive developmental ideas for any form of socio-economic development.

b) National Webinar on Role of Technologies in Rural Areas for Skill Development, Livelihood for Atmanirbhar Bharat scheduled on 16th June 2020: This webinar focused on the Contribution of CSIR-CBRI Technologies in Housing and Skill Development; Karigar Aur Kutir Udyog and Skill Development; Processing Agro-Residue to Value Added Products and Energy Self-Sufficiency in Rural Areas using Biomass: A model of Gram Urja Swaraj.

Title of the Activity 5: COVID-19 ESSENTIALS FOR THE VILLAGE CHILDREN

Need of the Activity: To help children prevent the spread of COVID -19

A meeting was conducted with the village heads as o the process of distribution. The village repress were asked to make a list of children would receive these items and all COVID 19 protocols to be followed were explained to them. On 31st July the items were handed over to the village representatives who were asked to distribute the same to the children in small groups.
