#### Introduction

The year marked the completion of the sesquicentenary celebration of the college. St. Xavier's College has been instrumental in contributing to the rich tradition of the educational culture of West Bengal and the nation for the past 150 years. The institution aims at the enhancement of the academic quality through innovation in teaching learning strategies.

The plan of action for the session 2010-11 are the following:-

- To make the course more professional and practical.
- To encourage new strategies of teaching.
- To encourage collaboration with other B.Ed. colleges through Teacher Exchange Programme and organization of seminars.
- To encourage Technological Upgradation in order to preserve and update information of the department related to the academic and non-academic needs.
- To upgrade technology based administration strategies through the B.Ed. hyper link on the college website.
- To provide professional training in teaching to the B.Ed. trainee teachers through Micro teaching, Block teaching, Internship and Practice Teaching.
- To develop the awareness towards social commitments and leadership skills through community outreach activities, students' club and village exposures.
- To involve the students in different activities of the department including administrative works like admission, publication of annual magazine, organizing seminars, workshops, educational tours.
- To organize UGC sponsored national seminar.
- To organize orientation programme for the teachers in the department.
- To organize mentoring system in the department in a more organized way.
- To invite professors of other colleges for pre- practice teaching session and to reorganize the pattern of practice teaching.
- To continue with curriculum restructuring so as to make it more practical, research based and career oriented.
- To increase the club activities in the department.
- To involve more students in personality development programmes, games and sports and other non- academic activities.
- To establish a separate IQAC in the department
- To procure one computer for the staffroom.



#### Section B – Details in respect of the following:-

#### 1. Activities reflecting the goals and Objectives of the institution.

The new academic year began with an exercise of orientation programme focused on our vision and mission statement. The inauguration of the new academic session was held on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2010 with the introduction of the freshers to the college. Inaugural programme started at 11 a.m. and Rev. Fr. George Ponadath Rector of the college, Rev. Fr. Dr. John Felix Raj, Principal of the college and other distinguished guests were present on the occasion. They gave a warm welcome to the new batch and spoke about the family spirit and atmosphere that exists in the college.

An orientation programme for the students of the B.Ed. department was held from 14.7.2010 to 16.7.2010 based on role play, debate and dramatics in teaching. On 24<sup>th</sup> July 2010 teacher's orientation programme was organized in the department. The resource person was Dr. P.K. Mishra, Director and Principal of IEM, who spoke on 'Towards Excellence in Teaching' which was highly enriching for the staff members.

B.Ed. Student's Council election was held from 27.7.2012 to 3.8.2012 for better functioning of the department with the help of the trainee teachers and the development of leadership skills among the trainee teachers.

On 6<sup>th</sup> September 2010 the B.Ed. department celebrated the Teacher's Day and developed a family spirit among staffs and students.

A seminar on "Teachers stress" was organized by the department in collaboration with Satyapriya Roy college of Education Kolkata on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2010. Eminent speakers delivered their lectures and the students of the department presented papers on selected topics. On 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> September 2010 the B.Ed. department underwent a rigorous pre-practice teaching session supervised by both external and internal professors.

Regular parent teacher meetings and Teacher – Headmaster/Headmistress interface were organized from time to time.

Innovative teaching strategies like Peer Team teaching, Seminar Mode of teaching were developed. Internship programme for the trainee teachers were conducted for three weeks before Puja holidays (two weeks in September and one week in October) It continued after the Puja holidays.

An educational tour was organized by the department to Shantiniketan on 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> December 2010 where the trainee teachers visited a tribal village and had interaction with the tribal people.

The month of January 2011 involved a lot of preparation for the admission of the students for 2011-12 session. On 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2011 the college celebrated its valedictory and convocation ceremony and our honorable governor Mr. M.K. Narayanan graced the occasion. On 8<sup>th</sup> January 2011 the annual college sports was held where B.Ed. department took part in March past and relay race and was awarded the prize of 'Second Highest Participation Contingent'. The B.Ed. students of 2010-11 showed outstanding performance in different interdepartmental football, volleyball and cricket matches throughout the academic session. The much-awaited UGC sponsored



National level seminar was organized by the department on 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2011 on 'Professionalism in Teacher. Education' in collaboration with Ramakrishna Mission Shikshana Mandira (Autonomous) Belur Math inaugurated by Rev. Father Dr. John Felix Raj, Principal of the college. The keynote address was delivered by the vice chairperson NCTE, Prof S. B. S. Chowdhury. The B.Ed. department remained busy with admission in the month of March 2011 and the session ended with practical and theoretical examination.

A get together of the outgoing batch of B.Ed. students was organized on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2011. The inaugural programme for the session 2011-12 was organized by the outgoing batch on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2011 which was the last ceremony of the academic session 2010-11.

The objectives of the B.Ed. course in 2010-11 were as follows:-

#### **Objectives**

- i. To make the course professional and practical
- ii. To bring about effective integration of different units of knowledge and corresponding training essentials for future teachers.
- iii. To make the trainee teachers competent to meet the challengers of the modern era.
- iv. To develop in the trainee teachers a positive attitude towards life in general and teaching in particular.
- v. To bring about all round development of trainee teachers to meet the challenges of the modern era.
- vi. To inculcate in the trainee teachers a sense of discipline, develop their moral values and awaken in them a thirst for knowledge.
- vii. To motivate the trainee teachers to inspire and guide the future generations.
- viii. To equip the trainee teachers with the skills needed in the age of Globalization, Liberalization and Privatization.

These objectives are made known to the stakeholders through the college website, notice boards and the college calendar which is distributed to every teachers and student at the beginning of the academic year.

In keeping with the aims and objectives mentioned above various activities had been included in the B.Ed. course:-

Professional training in teaching is provided to the B.Ed. trainee teacher through Micro teaching, Block teaching, Practice teaching.

Theoretical classes on teaching skills were held to develop a positive attitude towards this profession.

Different activities organized by 4 clubs helped them to be socially competent.

Regular mentoring sessions by the teacher mentors of the department were held in order to motivate, inspire guide the trainee teachers.

Training in administration was given to the B.Ed. trainee teachers through involvement of the students in different activities of the department like seminars, tours leadership training and training on citizenship through activities in student's, council, club activities, social service, outreach programme etc.

The department of education offers only one academic programme i.e. B.Ed. which is a one year programme.

#### 5. Examination Reforms incremented

Examination Reforms is a continuous process. In the first semester there was 100% external and 20% internal evaluation. However in the second semester we followed 100% internal and 20% external sample checking. If there was any discrepancy of more than 15% in the awarded marks between the internal and external examiner, then a third examiner was appointed for evaluation.

NET/SLET does not apply for B.Ed. course as B.Ed. is for school teaching. However many trainee teachers have qualified West Bengal school Service Commission Examination and placed in govt. and govt. aided schools.

However the ex-students of the department maintain close contact and render service whenever necessary. Moreover those students who are placed as heads of the schools help the department immensely in Practice Teaching and other activities of the department.

One of the teachers of the department is a member of Placement Cell Advisory Committee of the college.
