From the Principal's Desk



St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Kolkata has always strived to meet the challenges of enriching, encouraging and developing human capital for the betterment of society. From a very humble beginning in 1860, the college is now catering to more than 9500 students. Let me highlight a few salient characteristics of the College.

- It is one of the 53 Colleges run by the Jesuits in India. Vision and Mission of St. Xavier's flows from the charism of St. Ignatius who founded the Society of Jesus. The charism of Ignatius is centered around two great themes. First, is the inscription you would often see in pictures, books and even buildings – AMDG (Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam). This means for the Great Glory of God.

- The theme is what we call 'Majis' – the Greater – greater service to greater number of people.

- The motto of our College is 'Nihil Ultra' which means 'Nothing Beyond'.

- The University Grants Commission has upgraded St. Xavier's College with the status of College of Excellence.

- Our College has been assessed and accredited with Grade A++ with a CGPA score of 3.77 out of a scale of 4 in the third cycle of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Accreditation. This is the highest score of a College in the country.

- St. Xavier's College has been granted a "College with Heritage Status" by the University Grants Commission.

- It has also been assessed and certified as meeting the requirements of ISO 9001:2015 for providing higher education.

- St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Kolkata has secured 7th rank in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), 2020, published by MHRD on 11th June 2020.

Here at St. Xavier's College, we have begun to develop the idea of a new dispensation, shaped by a new vision for the future of this College. This vision will first be built upon the consolidation of our achievements and only then, can we safely embark on our policy of academic expansion. No longer can an academic institution rest upon its past and the laurels it has achieved. In a world where the rate of change accelerates faster and faster, we have to evolve and adapt and grow, commensurate to the world around us. So, the expansion we perceive will be mediated not entirely in terms of traditional academic norms. Rather we have begun to consider new kinds of subjects and subject combinations and interdisciplinary studies. Our faculty and diverse student body from various social walks of life, all contribute towards the same purpose: to maintain the college is an excellent reputation in education and to form men and women for others. Our course curriculum, across disciplines, aims to extract the best out of every individual who is a part of this institution. The choice-based credit and continuous internal assessments ensures that every Xaverian is competent enough to face challenges in life.



The students of these departments are encouraged to think of innovative projects and research that might enable us to contribute to the domain of knowledge and consultancy.

One hundred and sixty-one years after its humble beginning on January 16, 1860 with a first strength of 40 students, today, St. Xavier's College, Kolkata has grown in to a leading educational institution in India.

What began as a tiny seed grew into a mighty tree sheltering more than 700 students every year in its various departments. A total teaching staff of over 250 is educating them. The college offers UG and PG courses under five faculties: Arts, Science, Commerce, Business Administration and Education.

The College's motto is Nihil Ultra; significant and suggestive of a noble ideal, of an unconquerable hope, that should urge the Xaverian always to aim high. The motto of the young Xaverian is the old maxim: "Perfectum nihil est, aliquid dum restat agendum" (Nothing is perfect as long as anything remains to be done).

St. Xavier's College is run by the Society of Jesus, a Christian Religious Order, founded by Saint Ignatius of Loyola in 1540. It is one of the 24 University Colleges run by the Jesuits in India. The Jesuit College aims at forming young men and women of competence, commitment, compassion and conscience. St. Xavier's College thus aims at making its own contribution towards a transformation of the present-day social condition so that the principles of social justice, equality of opportunity, freedom and respect for religious and moral values, enshrined in the Constitution of India, may prevail, and the possibility of living a fully human existence may be open before all.

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NMC) recognized St. Xavier's College as an A++ grade institution in 2017. In May 2006, it was declared a Centre with College of Excellence by the UGC. From July 2006, it became an autonomous college (the first in West Bengal). The implication of autonomy is that the college is free to frame its own curriculum and courses of studies and at the same time it adopts innovative methods of teaching and undertakes a continuous process of performance evaluation through examinations.

St. Xavier's College has always been known for its cosmopolitan and all-India character. Coming as they do, from all over India and from various communities, students live in complete harmony, understanding and mutual respect. Thus they are encouraged to develop beyond local and group affinities, loyalties to the country and to society at large.

St. Xavier's College, which became the home of learned professors and zealous students, has all these 150 years remained steadfast and persevered in the midst of troubles and anxieties. Now with the richness of the past, it faces the future with the same spirit- Nihil Ultra (Nothing beyond).

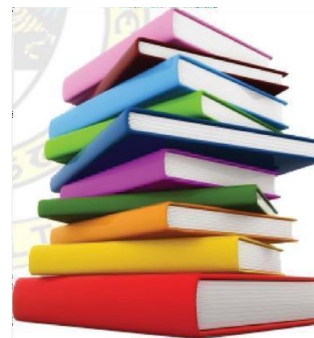

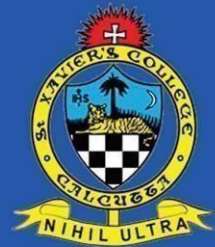
Recruitment

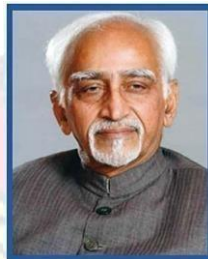

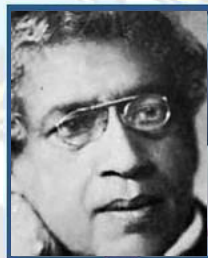

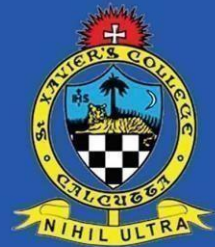

The Placement Cell launched in 2004-05, the first year after gaining autonomy, is a one point contact for all companies interested in inducting Xaverians in their organization either as employees or interns. Comprising of teacher coordinators, student representatives and headed by Mr. Niladri Sinha, the Placement Cell has been constituted with the following objectives:

- To act as an interface between the corporate world and the students in order to bridge the gap between them.
- To act as a contact point for all companies who wish to recruit students from St. Xavier's (Autonomous) College, Kolkata. The Placement Cell will facilitate the placement procedure from the pre-placement talks (PPT) to the induction process.
- To assist students in becoming ready for the corporate world by organising workshops for the outgoing students of the college.

Last Year (2020 - 2021) more than 650 students were recruited through the Placement Cell and we are expecting to place many more students in the current year (2021 - 2022).

St. Xavier's College has always strived to meet the challenges of enriching, encouraging and developing human capital for the betterment of the society. It is no exaggeration to state that the all-round formation offered at our institute has made our students valuable in the job market.

The specially designed courses supplanted with regular revisions and a continuous and vigorous examination pattern is responsible for keeping the students abreast with the new developments in their field of specialization as well as maintaining high academic standards. In addition, the credit system ensures the participation in varied extra-curricular activities ranging from sports to fests to NCC to management, you name it! The desire to face competition and succeed is reflected not only in academics as the college is also host to the country's best debaters, sports persons, artists and budding management mandarins.

In this context the role of the Placement Cell is in the capacity of an aid which hones the skills of the students by conducting seminars and mock GD/PI sessions, rendering them more industry-compatible. The Placement Cell also assists students in crafting their CV's and advises them in clinching a job of their choice.

The Placement Cell offers the following facilities to simplify the on-campus recruitment process for the companies:

- AV rooms for holding pre-placement talks.
- Auditorium of capacity [550] for presentations.
- Student representatives at every step for guidance and for all possible conveniences on the day of the visit.

Rules and Regulations

- The Placement Cell only acts as a platform for interaction between students and the corporate & does not assure any student of a placement.
- Students must apply to a corporate after careful consideration. Strict action will be taken against students who negatively impact the reputation of the College by their action or inaction while interacting with the corporate especially during the recruitment process.
- All companies will conduct a pre-placement talk.
- The Placement Cell is not responsible for the profile of job offered by the corporate. It is the duty of the student to clarify the same with the corporate.
- Students are advised to attend the PPT for information about the company profile, job description and the package.

Placement Policy

- The Placement Cell of the College will categorize the companies that come for recruitment into 3 categories (A, B, C). The category of a particular company will be informed to the students ahead of the company's arrival to the campus.
- If a student after the recruitment process is placed in a particular company (for eg. Company C1), he or she would not be allowed to apply to another company in the same category (for eg. Company C2). However, there will be an option for a „Dream Company“ . This means that the student can select or apply in any company in the other two categories (categories A or B).
- If a student is placed in any company of category B (for eg. Company B1), he or she would not be allowed to apply to any other company of category B (for eg. Company B2) nor to any company in category C (for eg. Company C1). However, he/she can apply to any company of category A.
- If a student is placed in any company in category A, he/she will exhaust all further placement opportunities.
- If a student's name is enlisted in the Waiting List of a particular company, it will not be considered as placed and he/she will be allowed to apply in other companies.
- If there is a time gap between the recruitment process and the declaration of the results by a particular company (say Company B1), the student will be allowed to apply to another company (say Company B2) during this period. But in case he/she is selected in Company B1 as well as Company B2, he/she will not be allowed to apply further(except for Category A Companies).
