Observations:

- *Cell functioning since inception of concept of NSS (1969)*
- Run by full time staff exclusive to NSS Cell doing excellent extension and outreach work
- Broadly 3 types of activities: Regular (Awareness sessions on COVID, Child Rights and Protection, Human trafficking, etc.), Annual (Awareness on AIDS, Gender issues, Shishu Mela, Children's Day celebration, etc.) and Special (Handicrafts Fair, Science awareness for underprivileged students, Participation in Unnat Bharat Abhiyan)

Areas of concern/Suggestions:

• Surveys to be done on the impact of the projects launched which would help understand the transformation in the socio economic and educational condition of the target group over a period of time.

Outreach Programme on Community Development Training: On 22nd March 2023, NSS Unit II has taken an initiative to form a self-help group with women from adopted villages. In order to step forward, a training session has been organised in collaboration with a NGO in the science hall of CSIR-Indian Institute of Chemical Biology. A total of 25 women undertook the training. As the consecutive step of the previously mentioned training programme, the self-help group of women (21 women) from adopted villages engaged themselves to organise a small scale trade fair at Indumati Sabhagriha, NCE Bengal with the help of NSS Unit II on 22nd April 2023.
